EASTON – Corridor Improvements on Washington Street (Route 138) Including Intersection Improvements at Elm Street

What is happening?

The purpose of this hearing is to provide the public with the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the proposed Route 138 corridor and Elm Street intersection improvement project. All views and comments submitted in response to the hearing will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.

How will this affect you?

The proposed corridor project consists of the installation of traffic and pedestrian signals at the intersection of Washington Street (Route 138) and Elm Street, including the realignment of the west leg of Elm Street with full depth roadway construction. In addition, the project will construct new accessible sidewalks and 5-foot buffered bicycle lanes along both sides of Washington Street, between Elm Street and Union Street, approximately 3,500 feet. The work will also include drainage improvements, pavement milling and overlay, box widening, signing and necessary landscaping.
