What is happening?

A Live Virtual Design Public Hearing will be hosted on the MassDOT website below to present the design for the RECONSTRUCTION OF MOUNT WASHINGTON ROAD (PHASE I) project in Egremont, MA. The purpose of this Design Public Hearing is to provide the public with the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the corridor improvements along the MOUNT WASHINGTON ROAD in Egremont, MA. All views and comments made at this hearing will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.

How will this affect you?

The proposed project consists of the western 1.2 miles of Mount Washington Road; from the Egremont/Mount Washington town line to 2,000-ft west of Jug End Road. This project is currently programmed in FFY 2026 of the Draft 2023-2027 TIP, which is currently out for public review and comment. The primary goals are to rehabilitate the roadway and improve safety along the corridor. Attendees will have the opportunity to ask questions and offer comments
