



Virtual Design Public Hearing – Bike Path Bridge over Route 140

What is happening?

A Live Virtual Design Public Hearing will be hosted on the MassDOT website below to present the design for the proposed BIKE PATH BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION, NORTH CENTRAL PATHWAY OVER ROUTE 140 project in Gardner, MA.

How will this affect you?

The proposed project consists of a new bicycle and pedestrian bridge and paved shared-use path approaches to the bridge, as well realigned paved access driveways on the north and south side of Route 140 (Green Street). The proposed shared-use path will be 10 feet in width and 3-foot shoulders for a total width of 16 feet. The access roads will be 11 feet wide and constructed with gravel south of Route 140 and paved with hot mix asphalt north of Route 140. The project length is approximately 1,400 linear feet. No changes to Route 140 are proposed as a part of this project.
