How will this affect you?

The proposed project consists of roadway improvements of West Main Street (Route-97) which will include roadway reconstruction, intersection realignment, sidewalk reconstruction, ADA compliant wheelchair ramps, a new closed drainage system, new signage, pavement markings, a multi-use path, and all related work. The work on King Street will be limited to resurfacing, signing and pavement markings.
