



DESIGN PUBLIC HEARING

BRIDGE REPLACEMENT, DIVISION STREET OVER HOUSATONIC RIVER, GREAT BARRINGTON, MA

What is happening?

The purpose of this hearing is to provide the public with the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the proposed Division Street over the Housatonic River bridge replacement project. All views and comments submitted in response to the hearing will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.

How will this affect you?

The proposed project consists of replacing the temporary bridge carrying Division Street over the Housatonic River with a bridge that will be designed for a 75-year lifespan. The proposed roadway is planned to have two 11 feet wide travel lanes. Bicycle accommodation consisting of five feet wide usable shoulders have been provided in accordance with applicable design guides. The total project length is approximately 500 feet long. During construction, detour has been proposed on Park Street and Van Deusenville Rd (approx. 5 mi) for two construction seasons.
