



# MassDOT Project #609202 - Resurfacing and Related Work on Montague City Road in Greenfield, MA

## What is happening?

A Live Virtual Design Public Hearing will be hosted on the MassDOT website below to present the design for the Resurfacing and Related Work on Montague City Road project in Greenfield, MA. The proposed project consists of resurfacing Montague City Road, and construction or reconstruction of: cement concrete pedestrian curb ramps and crossings; and hot mix asphalt sidewalks and driveways. Work as required: removing and resetting of curb, replacing existing guardrail as needed with new guardrail, and drainage alterations including: cleaning, adjusting, rebuilding, and new frames and grates. Also included: resetting traffic signs, placing final pavement markings, and completing incidental items.

## How will this affect you?

No construction start date of the proposed project has been set yet since it is currently in the design stage. At this time, the project is estimated to be advertised in late Winter of 2025-26 and construction could begin as early as the Spring of 2026.
