



Design Public Hearing: Jackson Road Bridge Replacement Project over the Nashua River in Harvard & Lancaster, MA

What is happening?

An In-Person Design Public Hearing will be conducted to present the design for the proposed bridge replacement project on Jackson Road over the Nashua River. This hearing will be conducted Live-In-Person.

How will this affect you?

The existing bridge will be widened to accommodate an additional southbound travel lane to Route 2 Westbound and additional shoulder widths. The new structure will carry three (3) 12'-0" lanes of traffic and provide (2) 4'-0" shoulders. Jackson Road does not include existing sidewalks and sidewalks are not proposed as part of this project. The replacement of the bridge will require phased construction and will include alternating one-way traffic under control of a temporary traffic signal. Access to all points north and south of the project will be maintained during construction.
