

# **Design Public Hearing** HAVERHILL – Roadway Reconstruction on North Ave.

### What is happening?

The purpose of this hearing is to provide the public with the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the proposed roadway project. All views and comments submitted in response to the hearing will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.

#### How will this affect you?

The proposed project consists of the reconstruction of North Avenue in Haverhill from the intersection with Main Street (Route 125) to the Plaistow, NH state border, approximately 1.86 miles. As part of the project, new ADA compliant sidewalks and granite curbing will be installed along both sides of North Avenue as well as bike lanes, narrower vehicular lanes, drainage and other utility upgrades and relocations. All intersections within the project limits will be reconstructed, with geometric improvements at the Gile Street intersection and installation of a mini-roundabout at the Marsh Avenue intersection. The existing North Avenue bridge over Snows Brook will be replaced. The existing Frye Pond will be drained to restore Snows Brook to its natural condition.
