What is happening?

A Design Public Hearing (DPH) will be held on-line (virtual) to present the design for the proposed Bridge replacement for Concord Road (Route 126) over MBTA tracks project. The Hearing will be held live but on-line/virtual. Access to the hearing can be found on the Mass.gov website below or using the QR code below.

How will this affect you?

This bridge needs to be replaced. It will be demolished in stages and replaced with a new bridge consisting of a 9-foot sidewalk, two 11-foot lanes and a 5-foot shoulder on the southbound side. A temporary pedestrian/utility bridge will be built to accommodate pedestrians through the work zone. The bridge will be built in stages and will accommodate signalized alternating one way traffic through the work zone.
