

## DESIGN PUBLIC HEARING Blueberry Hill Elementary School Improvements (Safe Routes To School) LONGMEADOW, MA

## What is happening?

A Live Virtual Design Public Hearing will be hosted on the MassDOT website below to present the design for the proposed Blueberry Hill Elementary School Improvements (Safe Routes To School) project in Longmeadow, MA.

## How will this affect you?

The proposed project consists of improving multimodal safety, mobility, and accessibility through sidewalk construction along the south side of Bliss Road between Grassy Gutter Road and Blueberry Hill Road and sidewalk and bicycle path construction along Blueberry Hill Road between Bliss Road and the school entrance. Crosswalks will be enhanced with MUTCD-compliant warning signage and rectangular rapid flashing beacons. Curb ramps will be reconstructed to be compliant with ADA/MAAB standards.
