



Resurfacing and Related Work on Longmeadow Street (Route 5) Phase 1

In-person Design Public Hearing

What is happening?

The purpose of this Design Public Hearing is to provide the public with the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the resurfacing and related work on Longmeadow Street (Route 5) Phase 1 in Longmeadow, MA. All views and comments made at the hearing will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.

How will this affect you?

Roadway rehabilitation will take place along Longmeadow Street. Additional improvements along the corridor include traffic signal upgrades and Accessible Pedestrian Systems (APS), bicycle accommodations, reconstruction of existing sidewalks and curb ramps in order to meet current ADA/AAB standards, installing or adjusting granite curbing, HMA Driveways, traffic signage and pavement markings. A secure Right-Of-Way is necessary for the subject project and as currently designed only temporary easements are anticipated. The roadway within this project is not anticipated to be detoured during construction.
