What is happening?

A Live Virtual Design Public Hearing will be hosted on the MassDOT website below to present the design for the Reconstruction & Related Work for VFW Highway project in Lowell, MA. The purpose of this Design Public Hearing is to provide the public with the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the corridor improvements along the VFW Highway in Lowell, MA. All views and comments made at this hearing will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.

How will this affect you?

The proposed project consists of milling and overlaying approximately 1.5 miles of roadway and replacing all sidewalk and pedestrian curb ramps within the project area that do not currently meet the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) / Massachusetts Architectural Access Board (AAB) standards. A shared use path will be constructed along VFW Highway from approximately Varnum Avenue to Mammoth Road. Some roadway restrictions will be required during construction but access to all properties will be maintained. Attendees will have the opportunity to ask questions and offer comments.
