How will this affect you?

The proposed project consists of The proposed project consists of two bridges will both be removed and replaced with one structure that will span over both existing bridge openings and the land that exists between the bridges. A secure right-of-way is necessary for this project. Acquisitions in fee and permanent or temporary easements may be required. The Town of Mansfield is responsible for acquiring all needed rights in private or public lands. The Town's policy concerning land acquisitions will be presented in the hearing.
