## What is happening?

A Live Virtual Design Public Hearing will be hosted on the MassDOT website to present the Multimodal Accommodations on School Street from Spring Street to West Street project in Mansfield, MA.

## How will this affect you?

The proposed project consists of the reconstruction of School Street from the Massachusetts State Layout just south of Spring Street to West Street. The proposed reconstruction will include full depth pavement, installation of new curbing, sidewalk, ADA compliant ramps, crosswalks, closed drainage system, and bicycle accommodations consisting of a 5-foot shoulder, striped as a bicycle lane.
