



Design Public Hearing: Spring Street Pedestrian/Bike Bridge over MBTA, Natick, MA

What is happening?

A Design Public Hearing will be held virtually to present the design for the proposed Spring Street Pedestrian/Bike Bridge superstructure replacement project over the MBTA. The Hearing will be live but conducted virtually/on-line only. Access to the Hearing can be found using the links provided below.

How will this affect you?

The existing bridge superstructure will be replaced with a new prefabricated truss bridge to accommodate pedestrian and bicycle traffic only. The existing granite block abutments will be re-used. The proposed bridge will accommodate a 14' wide path for pedestrians and bicyclists. Roadway improvements to the approaches between Cochituate Street and Middlesex Avenue will also be included. The bridge will be closed to pedestrians during construction and a detour route will be implemented.
