Intersection Improvements at Mount Pleasant Street and Nash Road, New Bedford, MA

What is happening?

The purpose of this Virtual Design Public Hearing is to provide the public with the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the Mount Pleasant Street at Nash Road Improvements Project in the City of New Bedford, MA. Reconstruction of this corridor and intersection will provide roadway safety improvements including new traffic and pedestrian signals, ADA compliant sidewalks and ramps, bicycle accommodations, pavement reconstruction, new signing and striping, improved street lighting, relocation of overhead wires and stormwater system improvements.

How will this affect you?

The project is designed to make the roads safer for everyone, improve traffic flow, and create better access for people walking or using bicycles. Access to residences will be maintained during construction. Work at the intersection will also involve temporary lane closures and may include short-term detours.
