What is happening?

A Live Virtual Design Public Hearing will be held online to present the design for the proposed Keyes Hill Road over Umpachene River Bridge Replacement Project in New Marlborough, MA. The hearing will be live but online/virtual only. Access to the hearing can be found on the mass.gov website listed below.

How will this affect you?

The proposed project consists of a bridge replacement. It will be demolished and replaced with a new bridge consisting of two 9-foot lane each way, replacing the one 14-foot-lane roadway that acts as a two-way traffic. There will be no pedestrian or bicycle accommodation as part of the bridge improvement.
