

Newton-Weston Bridge Bundle, Replacement and Rehabilitation at I-90/I-95 Including Ramp G Design Public Hearing

What is happening?

MassDOT will be replacing and rehabilitating a series of nine bridges at the I-90/I-95 interchange beginning in 2023. The purpose of this upcoming hearing is to provide the public with the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the project. All views and comments made at the hearing will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.

How will this affect you?

This project will impact the community and commuters during construction. During the Design Public Hearing, MassDOT will review the construction activities, project schedule, and anticipated impacts. Attendees will have the opportunity to ask questions and offer comments.
