

Virtual Design Public Hearing Reconstruction of Ashland Street

What is happening?

The purpose of this hearing is to provide the public with the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the proposed Reconstruction of Ashland Street project. All views and comments submitted in response to the hearing will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.

How will this affect you?

The proposed project is a Complete Streets project on a 0.75 mile stretch of Ashland Street from Main Street to Davenport Street. Pedestrian accommodations will be provided with fully accessible sidewalks along the entire corridor and crosswalks provided at every intersection. Bicycle circulation will be designed with the inclusion of bike racks installed at destination locations. Other accommodations will include improved signage, utilities, streetlighting transformations and landscape.
