



# Northbridge – Route 122 (Providence Rd) at School St, Sutton St, and Upton St Intersection Improvements Virtual Design Public Hearing

## What is Happening?

MassDOT will be hosting a virtual Design Public Hearing to provide the public the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the Northbridge – Route 122 (Providence Rd) at School St, Sutton St, and Upton St Intersection Improvements project. All views and comments submitted in response to the hearing will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.

## How Will this Affect You?

The proposed project consists of enhancing traffic, pedestrian, and bicyclist safety. The proposed design includes a signalized intersection, dedicated turn lanes, continuous sidewalks, and dedicated bicycle accommodations. Removal of a few on-street parking spaces is proposed on Sutton Street and Providence Road, which is necessary to provide space for traffic and safety improvements including dedicated vehicular turn lanes, bicycle lanes, and sidewalk widening.
