PEABODY – Independence Greenway Extension

What is happening?

The purpose of this hearing is to provide the public with the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the proposed trail project. All views and comments submitted in response to the hearing will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.

How will this affect you?

The proposed project consists of a continuation of the existing Independence Greenway from its present eastern terminus at the North Shore Mall to the Warren Street Extension/Endicott Street intersection. This will extend the existing 5.3-mile Greenway by 7,000 feet (1.3 miles) on a dedicated and protected 10-foot-wide two-way multiuse path. This project also includes: a Rectangular Rapid-Flashing Beacon (RRFB) crossing, new culverts, a new 80-foot span timber bridge, and a new 540-foot timber boardwalk. This segment extension will eventually be part of the Border to Boston trail.
