

612498 PITTSFIELD- BRIDGE REPLACEMENT, P-10-003 & P-10-032, SOUTH STREET (US

20/7) OVER HOUSATONIC RR & HOUSATONIC RIVER

What is happening?

A Design Public Hearing for the proposed bridge replacement of South Street (US 20/7) over Housatonic Railroad & Housatonic River within the City of Pittsfield will be held to present the design for the proposed projects. The purpose of this hearing is to provide the public the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the proposed projects and gather any local feedback that could be of value to the design team. The project consists of:

- Full replacement of two bridges in Pittfield, Massachusetts
- Bridge No. P-10-003, which spans the Housatonic Railroad, and Bridge No. P-10-032 which crosses the Housatonic River
- The roadway, South Street (US 20/7) will be widened to accommodate the new bridge widths, and include buffered bike lanes, pedestrian sidewalks, and a two-way continuous turn lane

How will this affect you?

During construction, traffic will be maintained with one northbound and one southbound lane. For certain construction activities, short term full road closures will be necessary, and a detour will be in place. The final conditions will provide two new bridges, two travel lanes (one for each direction), a continuous center turn lane, two buffered bike lanes, and two sidewalks.
