The purpose of this project is to provide safety improvements and improve pedestrian and bicyclist access in the vicinity of Beachmont Veterans Memorial School. The project includes a 10-foot shared use path in front of the school, a new crosswalk and bump out on Everard Street near Cottage Street, new sidewalks on Belle Isle Avenue, and new crosswalks and reconstructed pedestrian curb ramps on Crescent Avenue, Belle Isle Avenue, and Everard Street.
