

DESIGN PUBLIC HEARING Roadway Rehabilitation of Meadow Road Spencer, MA

What is happening?

A Live Virtual Design Public Hearing will be hosted on the MassDOT website below to present the design for the proposed Roadway Rehabilitation of Meadow Road project in Spencer, MA.

How will this affect you?

The proposed project consists of reconstruction of approximately 1.54-miles of Meadow Road, widening for bike accommodation, construction of new pedestrian sidewalks, transit accommodations, traffic safety, and drainage and stormwater quality improvements. Pedestrian and bicycle accommodations consisting of a 10-foot shared use foot path have been provided in accordance with applicable design guides.
