

Reconstruction of Birnie Ave at Gerena School Pedestrian Tunnel

What is happening?

This Design Public Hearing is being conducted to allow the public to become fully acquainted with this Birnie Avenue Reconstruction project (MassDOT Project #610664). MassDOT and Design Consultants will present the current design plans, anticipated construction schedule and general construction impacts.

How will this affect you?

Due to on-going speeding concerns, a permanent speed table is proposed in the vicinity of the Gerena School Pedestrian Tunnel. Additionally, to address water infiltration issues in the Pedestrian Tunnel, waterproofing methods are proposed. As part of the construction, Birnie Avenue is not anticipated to be fully closed, however one travel lane may be closed at a time throughout the duration of construction.
