Stormwater Drainage Improvements at Wachusett Reservation on Route 110 (Metropolitan Road)

What is happening?

The proposed project consists of stormwater improvements to approximately 1,650 feet of Route 110, eliminating a direct stormwater outfall to the Wachusett Reservoir. The project will also reconstruct the road including lowering a vertical curve to improve sight distance for drivers near the entrance to the North Dike Trail and adding guardrail in some areas.

How will this affect you?

Construction of the improvements will require lane closures during the workday with potential for short-term detours during limited phases of the work.
