



Design Public Hearing Intersection Improvements At Route 140 and Route 62 Sterling, MA

What is happening?

MassDOT is holding a Design Public Hearing to present the design of a roundabout and safety improvements at the intersection of Route 140 and Route 62 in Sterling, MA. All views and comments submitted in response to the hearing will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.

How will this affect you?

The proposed project includes the construction of a one-lane, peanut-shaped roundabout with bicycle accommodation, ADA-compliant pedestrian facilities, and new crosswalks. The project will provide sidewalks and accessible curb ramps where appropriate to improve pedestrian safety and connectivity. The overall purpose of the project is to create a safer, more efficient, and more accessible intersection for all roadway users.
