

Design Public Hearing Sutton/Grafton – Depot St over the Blackstone River – Bridge Replacement

What is happening?

This project proposes to replace the Depot Street bridge over the Blackstone River in the towns of Sutton and Grafton, MA. The project will address structural deficiencies and provide a new bridge that will last for many decades. It will also improve safety and pedestrian access by providing sidewalks on both sides of the bridge.

How will this affect you?

A full bridge closure will be required and traffic detours will be provided. There will be some impacts to abutting properties during construction as well as in the final condition. All of these impacts will be presented at the hearing and there will be an opportunity to raise questions and concerns.
