



Route 140 Corridor Improvements Design Public Hearing

What is happening?

The purpose of this Design Public Hearing is to provide the public with the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the Route 140 Corridor Improvement project in Upton, MA. All views and comments made at the hearing will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.

How will this affect you?

Currently, the Route 140 corridor does not meet current ADA standards and lacks multi-modal accommodations, including bicycle lanes and sidewalks along both sides of Route 140. The intersection at Main Street, Grove Street, North Main Street, and Church Street is unconventional. Improvements along this section of Route 140 will improve safety through construction of sidewalks along both sides and bicycle lanes and construct a roundabout at the Main Street/ Grove Street/Church Street intersection to clarify operations.
