What is happening?

The purpose of this hearing is to provide the public with the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the proposed replacement of Route 140 Culvert over Unnamed Tributary in the Town of Upton.

Will this affect you?

A secure Right-Of-Way is necessary for the subject project. Temporary & Permanent easements will be required for the construction of the project. Roadways within the project area will remain open to traffic throughout the construction phase. Access to all residences & businesses will be maintained during construction phase. Abutters will be notified 24 hours in advance should access to their property need to be restricted.
