Rehabilitation of Route 16 (Douglas Street), from Taft Hill Road to 200-Foot West of Main Street Uxbridge, MA

What is happening?

The purpose of this hearing is to provide the public with the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the proposed Rehabilitation of Route 16 (Douglas Street), from Taft Hill Road to 200-feet west of Main Street. All views and comments submitted in response to the hearing will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.

How will this affect you?

The proposed project consists of corridor improvements on Route 16 from Taft Hill Road to 200-feet west of Main Street. The project will include a shared-use path adjacent to the north side of Douglas Street, the replacement and extension of sidewalks to Hunter Road on the southside of Douglas Street, drainage improvements, addition of crosswalks, ADA complaint ramps and roadway alignment adjustments.
