

# DESIGN PUBLIC HEARING Rehabilitation of Mount Auburn Street (Route 16) WATERTOWN, MA

# What is happening?

A Live Virtual Design Public Hearing will be hosted on the MassDOT website below to present the design for the proposed Rehabilitation of Mount Auburn Street project in Watertown, MA.

## How will this affect you?

The project includes the reconstruction of Mt. Auburn Street from the Cambridge City Line to the intersection with Summer Street, just east of Watertown Square, approximately 9,300 feet. The rehabilitation of the corridor involves the alteration of travel lanes and roadway geometry, including the implementation of a road diet. Bicycle accommodations including on-street buffered and non-buffered bicycle lanes, bus/bicycle lanes, and shared lanes (sharrows) are proposed along the corridor as space permits. Corridor wide Improvements also include the reconstruction of existing traffic signals, ADA compliant pedestrian facilities, and modernization of bus stops.
