## Intersection Improvements Route 6 & Main Street and Pavement Preservation of Route 6

### What is happening?

MassDOT will be making improvements to Route 6 and the intersection with Main Street. Traffic signals will be upgraded, pavement will be replaced, and bicyclist and pedestrian access improved. The purpose of this hearing is to provide the public with the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the proposed project. All views and comments made at the hearing will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.

### How will this affect you?

During the public hearing, MassDOT will review the construction activities and schedule, right-of-way procurement, improvements to bicycle and pedestrian connectivity, and impacts to the community. Attendees will have the opportunity to ask questions and offer comments.
