## WILLIAMSTOWN – Intersection Improvements at Route 7 and Route 43

### What is happening?

The purpose of this Design Public Hearing is to provide the public with the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the Intersection Improvements at Route 7 and Route 43 Project in Williamstown, MA. All views and comments made at the hearing will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.

### How will this affect you?

The project intersection has experienced above-average crash rates in recent years. The proposed project consists of constructing a roundabout to improve safety and operations. Pedestrian connections between The Store at Five Corners and Bloedel Park will be improved with a new marked crosswalk and accessible ramps to cross the south leg of Route 7. Landscaping enhancements are proposed to create a welcoming gateway to Williamstown.
