

DESIGN PUBLIC HEARING Replacement of the Main Street Bridge over Hemlock Brook

What is happening? Williamstown, MA

A Live Virtual Design Public Hearing will be hosted on the MassDOT website below to present the design for the replacement of the Bridge over the Hemlock Brook along Main Street project in Williamstown, MA.

How will this affect you?

The proposed project consists of replacing the bridge that carries Main Street over the Hemlock Brook. The bridge is located between Belden Street and Buxton Hill Road on Main Street. The width of the new bridge will be the same as the existing bridge at 28 feet. The bridge will include a new wider sidewalk at 5 feet. Approximately 200 feet of Main Street will be reconstructed on both ends of the bridge. The bridge will be closed for about 9 months during construction. A detour will be posted for motor vehicles. A temporary bridge will be provided for pedestrians and bicycles.
