



# Design Public Hearing Ledge Stabilization on Route 7 Between Mile Markers 51.9 and 52 Williamstown, MA

## What is happening?

A design public hearing is being held to share information regarding the replacement of the existing retaining wall on Route 7 in Williamstown between Mile Markers 51.9 and 52. This wall supports the Jamieson Heights roadway and needs repair. The design public hearing will describe the design of the proposed wall and the impacts of the construction on traffic accessing Jamieson Heights.

Traffic congestion may occur during construction. Utility poles will be relocated.
