

Intersection Reconstruction at Route 3 (Cambridge Road) & Bedford Road and South Bedford Street - Virtual Design Public Hearing

What is happening?

MassDOT will hold a hearing to inform the public about the proposed intersection improvements project in Woburn and Burlington. The Department will discuss in depth the proposed project which will include the traffic and roadway improvements at the intersection of Route 3 (Cambridge Road) at Bedford Road and South Bedford Street. There has been a long-standing need to address traffic congestion, improve safety, and improve pedestrian and bicycle mobility through the intersection.

How will this affect you?

The project will have temporary impacts to the motoring public as well as pedestrians and bicyclists during construction. Proposed improvements consist of widening the existing roadways to provide adequate turn lanes, bicycle lanes, sidewalks and other Complete Streets components, in addition to a new traffic signal system.
