Harrison & Laurel St. Bridges in Worcester

What is happening?

The purpose of this Design Public Hearing is to provide the public with the opportunity to become fully acquainted with the proposed roadway improvements along I 290, the replacement of the Harrison Street Bridge over I 290, and the replacement of the Laurel Street Bridge over I 290 in Worcester.

How will this affect you?

While safe for travel, the bridges within the project area are deficient and in need of replacement and rehabilitation. Both bridges will be replaced with a new bridge in a similar location. The project will improve sidewalks and add crosswalks. During construction there will be a one lane traffic moving towards eastbound over the bridge with a minimum 11' wide temporary lane.
