



Pedestrian & Bicycle Improvements Pleasant Street, Worcester, MA

What is happening?

MassDOT is holding a Design Public Hearing to present the design and safety improvements on Pleasant Street from Sunny View Heights to South Orleans Street in Worcester, MA. All views and comments submitted in response to the hearing will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.

How will this affect you?

The proposed project consists of enhancing the safety of pedestrians and bicyclists on Pleasant Street by reconstructing existing sidewalks, constructing new 5-foot-wide sidewalks where feasible, adding 5-foot-wide bike lanes along the roadway, and incorporating additional pedestrian crossings across Pleasant Street with the addition of ADA compliant curb ramps at each intersection. The project will retain the existing curb line in most locations and maintain the existing utility poles. Bicycle accommodation consisting of a 5-foot-wide bicycle lane has been provided in accordance with applicable design guides.
