



Flood Relief on Route 20 Design Public Hearing

What is happening?

The purpose of this meeting is to update the public on the design status, to become fully acquainted with this project, and to understand MassDOT's decision to move forward with the Flood Relief on Route 20, Grafton Street (RT 122) Interchange to Flint Pond project in Worcester and Shrewsbury. Public comments and concerns are being solicited and will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.

How will this affect you?

The goal of this project is to improve flooding issues at the intersection of RT 20 and RT 122 which causes unpredictable lane closures during heavy rainfall events. MassDOT is proposing the installation of new stormwater infrastructure at the intersection and along Route 20 to Flint Pond. The installation of new stormwater infrastructure will result in lane closures along RT 20 for the duration of construction, potentially impacting travel times in the area.
