What is happening?

A design public hearing is being held to record public feedback on a project to signalize the intersection of Route 1A at North and Winter Streets in Wrentham, MA.

How will this affect you?

The project proposes to install a traffic signal to improve safety and operations at this high-crash location. Pedestrians will be provided with sidewalks on Route 1A and shared-use paths on the side streets. Bicyclists will have on-road buffered bicycle lanes on Route 1A and shared-use paths on the side streets.
