



Why was this project initiated?

Project Need

Existing pedestrian curb ramps may not be ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act)-compliant for one or more of the following reasons:

- Surface material condition
- Vertical alignment
- Level landing or turning space size
- Running slope or cross slope
- Missing detectable warning panel
- Missing reciprocal ramp
- Physical obstructions







What do we want to accomplish?

Project Objectives

- Improve safety
- Improve mobility
- Improve pedestrian connectivity
- Provide better crosswalk visibility
- Remove obstructions
- Meet ADA compliance
- Minimize ROW (Rightof-Way) impacts

Hatfield Chestnut Street near I-91








Hatfield Route 5 & Route 10 near I-91






PALMER ROAD (ROUTE 32)



Monson Main Street (Route 32) at King Avenue



































Orange South Main Street (Route 122) over Route 2





















Whately State Road (Route 5 & 10) near Lasalle Drive









Whately State Road (Route 5 & 10) near Old State Road















BITUMINIOUS ACT







Right of Way (ROW) discussion

- MassDOT is responsible for acquiring all necessary rights in public land for design, construction, and implementation of the project.
- Affected property owners will be contacted by personnel from the MassDOT ROW Bureau.
- Procedures must comply with state and federal regulations governing the right-of-way acquisition process.
 - Property owners are protected under Massachusetts General Laws, primarily Chapter 79.
 - If project receives federal funds, property owners are further protected under Title III of the Real Estate Property Act of 1970, as amended.
- Fee takings, permanent easements, and/or temporary construction easements may be required.

Environmental Impacts

- Conservation

 - Coordination is ongoing









Construction Process

- Construction to begin Fall
 2024 throughout MassDOT
 District 2.
- Construction duration anticipated to take approximately one year (finish Fall 2025)
- Exact construction
 schedule of each location
 to be determined





Pedestrian & Bicycle Impacts

- Pedestrian accessibility compliance will be provided throughout the project area, including during construction
- Temporary sidewalk and ramp closures will occur in order to reconstruct new facilities
- Temporary pedestrian crossings and pedestrian ramps will be provided during construction
- No separated bicycle facilities currently exist within the project limits





Traffic Impacts

- Minimal impacts to vehicular traffic ٠
- MassDOT reviews all Traffic Management Plans (TMPs) submitted by the Contractor in accordance with current standards and regulations
- Advanced construction warning signs will be implemented and police details will be utilized when necessary
- Variable message (VMS) boards will be implemented on affected roadways
- No long-term road closures or detours will occur as part of this project
