




# Why was this project initiated?

# **Project Need**

Existing pedestrian curb ramps may not be ADA-compliant for one or more of the following reasons:

- Surface material condition
- Vertical alignment
- Level landing or turning space size
- Running slope or cross slope
- Missing detectable warning panel
- Missing reciprocal ramp
- Physical obstructions






## Framingham Hollis Street (Route 126) at Bates Road and McAlee Avenue






## Framingham Hollis Street (Route 126) at Foss Road






#### Framingham Hollis Street (Route 126) at Guild Road






#### Framingham Hollis Street (Route 126) at Whitney Avenue






#### Framingham Hollis Street (Route 126) at Draper Road






## Milford West Street (Route 140) at Cunniff Avenue










## Northbridge Providence Road (Route 122) at Dudley Avenue








#### Northbridge Providence Road (Route 122) at Edgemere Avenue








## **Sudbury** Boston Post Road (Route 20) at Bigelow Drive






## **Sudbury** Boston Post Road (Route 20) at Carding Mill Road






## **Sudbury** Boston Post Road (Route 20) at Uplook Drive






### Worcester Millbury Street (Route 146) at Esther Street






#### Worcester Millbury Street (Route 146) at Maxwell Street






#### Worcester Millbury Street (Route 146) at Accommodation Street






#### Worcester Millbury Street (Route 146) at Burton Street






#### Worcester Millbury Street (Route 146) at Fifth Avenue






#### Worcester Millbury Street (Route 146) at Perry Avenue

# How will your property be impacted?

### Right of Way (ROW) discussion

- MassDOT is responsible for acquiring all necessary rights in public land for design, construction, and implementation of the project.
- Affected property owners will be contacted by personnel from the MassDOT ROW Bureau.
- Procedures must comply with state and federal regulations governing the right-of-way acquisition process.
  - Property owners are protected under Massachusetts General Laws, primarily Chapter 79.
  - If project receives federal funds, property owners are further protected under Title III of the Real Estate Property Act of 1970, as amended.
- Fee takings, permanent easements, and/or temporary construction easements may be required.

# What is the construction approach?

## **Construction Process**

- Construction to begin Fall 2024 throughout MassDOT District
   3.
- Construction duration
   anticipated to take
   approximately one year (finish Fall 2025)
- Exact construction schedule of each location to be determined





## Pedestrian & Bicycle Impacts

- ADA compliance will be provided throughout the project area, including during construction
- Temporary sidewalk and ramp closures will occur in order to reconstruct new facilities
- Temporary pedestrian crossings and pedestrian ramps will be provided during construction
- No separated bicycle facilities currently exist within the project limits





### **Traffic Impacts**

- Minimal impacts to vehicular traffic
- MassDOT reviews all Traffic
   Management Plans (TMPs)
   submitted by the Contractor in
   accordance with current standards
   and regulations
- Advanced construction warning signs will be implemented and police details will be utilized when necessary
- Message boards will be implemented on affected roadways
- No long-term road closures or detours will occur as part of this project
