






# **Project Area**

Lakeview Avenue from Primrose Hill Road to Gerard Street/Phineas Street (approximately 6,000 feet)

#### School Complex includes:

- Dracut High School
- Richardson Middle School
- Englesby Elementary School
- Brookside Elementary School



# **Project Funding**

- Total current estimate is \$4,465,215.00
  - materials (bid items)
  - police details
  - utility relocation (as needed)
- Project must be programmed in the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) in the appropriate Federal Fiscal Year
- Funding breakdown –
   80% federal, 20% state
- Does not include ROW acquisition costs






# Why was this project initiated?

# Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Program

- SRTS is a federally funded program administered by MassDOT that works to increase
- Provides improvements free to schools and communities
- Safe walking, biking, and rolling among public elementary, middle, and high school students
- Collaborative, community-focused approach to bridge the gap between health and transportation
- Infrastructure projects like 609510 Dracut aim to create conditions that allow students to safely enjoy an active commute to school





### Project Needs and Goals – Sidewalks

- Existing Conditions:
  - Poor sidewalk condition
  - Gaps in sidewalk connectivity
  - Missing curb ramps at crosswalk
  - Non-ADA compliant sidewalks and curb ramps (steep slope or missing detectable warning panel)

#### Improvements:

- Reconstruct sidewalks and curb ramps to be compliant with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and Public Right-of-Way Accessibility Guidelines (PROWAG) requirements
- Construct new sidewalk to complete network







# Project Needs and Goals – Pedestrian Crossings

- Existing Conditions:
  - Missing crosswalks along desire lines
  - Inconsistent crosswalk treatments
  - Long pedestrian crossings
- Improvements:
  - Restripe crosswalks with a high-visibility style for added pedestrian crossing safety
  - Add midblock crossings with Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFBs)
  - Add median islands at select locations for pedestrian refuge





### Project Needs and Goals – Intersections

#### Primrose Hill Road

- Existing Conditions:
  - Large radius on the northeast corner
    - > Promotes high-speed right-turns
  - No sidewalk connectivity
- Improvements:
  - Tighten intersection corners
  - Add sidewalk, curb ramps, and crosswalk across Primrose Hill Road





### Project Needs and Goals – Intersections

#### <u>Signalized Intersections on Lakeview Avenue</u>

- Tennis Plaza Road
- Litchfield Avenue/School Complex Driveway
- New Boston Road/High School Driveway
- Gerard Street/Phineas Street

#### Existing Conditions:

- Missing one leg of crosswalk across Lakeview Ave at Tennis Plaza Road intersection and Litchfield Ave/School Complex Driveway intersection.
- Existing pedestrian signals are outdated and some are not functioning

#### **Improvements:**

- Add new crosswalks
- Upgrade to Accessible Pedestrian Signals (APS)
   Optimize signal timing







# Project Needs and Goals - Bicycle Accommodations

- Existing Conditions:
  - Limited to buffered bicycle lanes between Elm Street and Tennis Plaza Road (approx. 1,000 feet)
  - No bicycle detection at signalized intersections

- Improvements:
  - Continuous buffered bicycle lanes throughout study corridor (approx. 6,000 feet)
  - Green bicycle crossing markings and turning boxes at all signalized intersections

























# How will your property be impacted?

# Preliminary Right of Way (ROW) Discussion

- The Town of Dracut is responsible for acquiring all necessary rights in public land for design, construction, and implementation of this project.
- Affected property owners will be contacted by personnel from the Municipality ROW Bureau or consultants representing the responsible agency.
  - Property owners are protected under Massachusetts General Laws, primarily Chapter 79.
  - If Project receives federal funds, property owners are further protected under Title III of the Real Property Act of 1970, as amended
- Fee takings, permanent easements, and or temporary construction easements may be required.
- Preliminary ROW drawings will be available at Town Hall Engineering Department for public review and comment.

At this stage of design, the Right of Way process has not been finalized. This meeting is an opportunity for the public to comment on any impacts to properties.



# **Environmental Permitting**

- Very limited environmental permitting needed
- Construction work within wetland buffer zone
- No wetland impacts anticipated
- No historic and/or cultural impacts anticipated
- Minimal increase in impervious area
   (primarily reconstructing existing sidewalk)







How will the road user be affected?


#### **Construction Impacts**

- Construction to take place over 1year period
- Potential lane closures during construction activities
- No closures or detours anticipated
- Abutter access will be maintained throughout construction
- Close coordination with District 4
   Construction, construction
   contractor, and Town of Dracut
- Intersections
  - Primrose Hill Road
  - Tennis Plaza Road
  - Lichfield Avenue
  - New Boston Road
  - Gerard Street/Phineas Street
