









Location Map

What do we want to accomplish?


Project Goals

- Remove structurally deficient dam and restore Snows Brook
- Replace structurally deficient bridge
- Minimize impacts to traveling public and abutters
- Traffic and Complete Street Improvements
 - Implement mini-roundabout at North Ave/Marsh Ave intersection
 - Implement geometric improvements at North Ave/Main St (Route 125) and North Ave/Giles St intersections
 - Bicycle lanes full length of project limits
 - Install ADA compliant pedestrian sidewalks






Proposed Improvements Overview – How did we get here?






Proposed Improvements - Typical Roadway Cross Section








Proposed Improvements – North Ave at Main St (Route 125)






Proposed Improvements – North Ave at School Drop-Off Lane




Proposed Improvements – North Ave at Marsh Ave & Tenadel Ave






Proposed Improvements – North Ave at Concord St






Proposed Improvements – North Ave at Gile St






Proposed Improvements – North Ave at Bridge









What is the construction approach?

Construction Approach

- Maintain one lane of travel in each direction on North Avenue
 - No long-term detours or roadway closures are anticipated
- Construction may begin as soon as Spring 2025 (pending funding)
 - Construction duration anticipated to take two years
 - Any construction schedule updates will be communicated on MassDOT project website
- Notices will be provided from the City or Contractor to impacted residents prior to work beginning
- Advanced construction warning signs will be implemented and police details utilized where necessary





How will your property be impacted?

Preliminary Right of Way (ROW) discussion 25% Design Public Hearing

- Haverhill is responsible for acquiring all necessary rights in public land for design, construction, and implementation of this project.
 - Fee takings, permanent easements and/or temporary construction easements may be required.
- Affected property owners will be contacted by personnel from the City of Haverhill or consultants representing the City of Haverhill
 - Property owners are protected under Massachusetts General Laws, primarily Chapter 79.
 - For any project receiving federal funds, property owners are further protected under Title III of the Real Property Act of 1970, as amended.

At this stage of design, the Right of Way acquisition process has not been initiated. This meeting is an opportunity for the public to comment on any impacts to properties.
