



Why was this project initiated?

Project Needs

- Traffic congestion and bus maneuvering challenges in the pickup/drop-off area. ullet
- Safety concerns due to: ullet
 - i. obstructed sight lines,
 - ii. two-way traffic on Spruce Street, and

iii. driver non-compliance with traffic and parking rules

- Insufficient pedestrian accommodations, including lack of ADA-compliant ulletwheelchair ramps and failure to yield at crosswalks
- Poor drainage along Arlington Street corridor ullet




Existing Conditions


Lack of ADA-compliant pedestrian curb ramps

Project Goals

- Enhance pedestrian safety, accessibility, and mobility for • students and the community around the school
- Calm vehicular traffic and improve roadway crossing safety near the school
- Enhance Circulation and Mobility around pickup/drop-off area
- Address drainage issues to support a safer and more accessible environment





Cross Section of Arlington Street Corridor




Improvements at Arlington Street / Broadway Intersection





Preliminary Right of Way (ROW) discussion 25% Design Public Hearing

- City of Lawrence is responsible for acquiring all necessary rights in public land for design, construction, and implementation of this project.
 - Fee takings, permanent easements and/or temporary construction easements may be required.
- Affected property owners will be contacted by personnel from the City of Lawrence ROW Bureau or consultants representing the responsible agency.
 - Property owners are protected under Massachusetts General Laws, primarily Chapter 79.
- Preliminary ROW drawings will be available at the Office of Planning and Development, City of Lawrence for public review and comment.


At this stage of design, the Right of Way process has not been finalized. This meeting is an opportunity for the public to comment on any impacts to properties.





MASSACHUSETTS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

Construction Phases



- Administered by MassDOT
- Operations will be coordinated with MassDOT and City Officials
- Access will be maintained as much as possible to abutting homes and businesses
- Pedestrian access will be maintained
- Temporary traffic control signage will be provided
- Night work not anticipated
- Parking may be temporarily impacted
