


Travelling Eastbound on Chauncy Street




CHAUNCY ST. AND COMMERCIAL ST. INTERSECTION



- Provide right turn lane in eastbound direction.
- Provide right turn slip ramp in the westbound direction.
- Upgrade traffic signal equipment
- Coordinate intersection with 5 other intersections along Route 140 corridor.




Project Scope CHAUNCY ST. (ROUTE 106)



- Combine overhead utilities and

- Add turn lanes on all
- Provide right turn slip ramp in southbound direction
- Upgrade traffic signal







Right of Way (ROW) discussion

- Responsible for acquiring all necessary rights in public land for design, construction, and implementation of a project.
- Affected property owners will be contacted by personnel from the ROW Bureau or the Town of lacksquareMansfield.
- Procedures must comply with state and federal regulations governing the acquisition process. ullet
 - Property owners are protected under Massachusetts General Laws, primarily Chapter 79.
 - If project receives federal funds, property owners are further protected under Title III of the Real Property Act of 1970, as amended.
- Fee takings, permanent easements, and/or temporary construction easements may be required. ullet

- Phased Construction

- One lane of traffic maintained at all times
- Shoulder encroachment
- Peak hour restrictions
- Pedestrian accommodation
- Normal traffic operations during nonwork hours







Project Budget and Funding

Budget and Funding

- Estimated total project cost ~ \$8 Million based on 25% Design ulletThe total estimated cost of the project does not include any right of way acquisition costs.
- Federal Highway Administration funding 80% (Federal Aid)
- MassDOT funding 20% (remaining construction cost) lacksquareThis project must be programmed in the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) in the appropriate Federal Fiscal Year in order for MassDOT to solicit bids for eventual construction.
