





Project Initiation

- Identified as a desired connection on several regional plans:
 - Metropolitan Area Planning Council (MAPC) Regional Greenway Network (LandLine)
 - Mystic Greenways Initiative by the Mystic River Watershed Association
 - 2009 Mystic River Master Plan created by the Massachusetts Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR)

Project Goals


- Improve Bicycle and Pedestrian Safety


Path Alternatives Considered

Preferred Alternative Circulation Plan










Path Section




Boardwalk Section

How will your property be impacted?

Right of Way (ROW) discussion – 25% Design

- Responsible for acquiring all necessary rights in public land for design, construction, and implementation of a project.
- Affected property owners will be contacted by personnel from the City of Medford or the Massachusetts
 Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR).
- Procedures must comply with state and federal regulations governing the acquisition process.
 - Property owners are protected under Massachusetts General Laws, primarily Chapter 79.
 - If project receives federal funds, property owners are further protected under Title III of the Real Property Act of 1970, as amended.






