



Beades Bridge Replacement Project

What is happening?

MassDOT will host a live, in-person public meeting to provide the community with an opportunity to become fully acquainted with the proposed project to replace the John J. Beades Bridge which carries Morrissey Boulevard over Dorchester Bay in the Savin Hill neighborhood of Boston, Massachusetts. While the existing bridge remains safe for all users, the structure has reached the end of its useful life span and should be replaced to ensure it can continue to provide a safe, multimodal crossing of Boston Harbor.

How will this affect you?

The proposed project includes the reconstruction of the Beades Bridge. It is anticipated that a temporary bridge and closures of the navigation channel below the bridge will be required during portions of the replacement project. Any closure of the navigation channel will be coordinated with local mariners, the Boston Police Marine Unit, and the United States Coast Guard. All views and comments submitted at the meeting will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.
