



Public Information Meeting – Bourne Rail Trail (Phase 2)

What is happening?

The Town of Bourne and MassDOT are hosting a live Public Information Meeting (PIM) for the Bourne Rail Trail (Phase 2) project. The Phase 2 project limits are from Monument Neck Road to Valley Bars Road – a total length of 2.08 miles. The purpose of this meeting is to provide an update on the project's alternatives analysis efforts. Information will be available on project history, trail alignment evaluation, and potential impacts. All views and comments submitted in response to these events will be reviewed and considered to the maximum extent possible.

How will this affect you?

The Town of Bourne is seeking to implement a shared-use path to connect the Cape Cod Canal bike path in Bourne to the Shining Sea Bikeway in Falmouth. The connection would provide a regional off-road bike facility that would provide multimodal travel through the Towns of Bourne, Sandwich, and Falmouth. This project will be one of four phases.
